Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

1. What types of projects are supported?

Projects should focus on innovative solutions in biomedical or health-related fields. These may include:

- Therapeutics (drug discovery, biologics)
- Medical devices
- Diagnostics and biomarkers
- Digital health and Al applications

2. How do I apply?

3. What are the eligibility criteria?

The PI (or Co-PI) must be a full member of Sylvester's (Cancer Centers Support Grant) CCSG.

4. What is some general application advice?

- Understand the medical context in which your therapeutic or wearable will make a difference.
- Talk to clinicians who know the field before applying.
- Relate how your solution solves the identified problem. A mismatch between the solution and the need will be noticed.
- Include preliminary results and a research plan, focusing on critical data demonstrating feasibility and experiments showing translatability.
