With over \$2.4M in NIH research funding, we are dedicated to exploring the latest discoveries in the laboratory and accelerating the most promising therapies in our clinics.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

UHealth Ear Institute: The Institute is one of the largest and most comprehensive in the country, with services in otology, neuro-otology, audiology, vestibular disorders, tinnitus, and auditory implants. Our pediatric component consists of our Children's Hearing Program (CHP) and the Kids Hear Now (KHN) Cochlear Implant Family Resource Center.

Head and Neck Surgery Division: The Division has nine head and neck surgeons – one of the largest teams of its kind – and is known for successful clinical trials and research in head, neck, and oral treatments. The Division has a multidisciplinary tumor board for treatment planning that was established over 40 years ago.

UHealth Laryngology and Voice Division: The Division focuses on laryngeal and vocal cord surgery, comprehensive speech therapy, and vocal pedagogy.

UHealth Pediatric Otolaryngology: Our fellowship-trained physicians treat a range of conditions, from tonsillitis to more unusual disorders involving the upper airways, chronic ear disease, and acquired or congenital masses of the head and neck.

Rhinology, Sinus, and Nasal Care: Our physician experts perform endoscopic sinus surgery and anterior endoscopic skull base surgery. We treat simple nosebleeds to severe levels of sinusitis and complications with smell and taste.

UHealth Sleep Medicine/Sleep Surgery: Our Center is South Florida's only fully accredited comprehensive sleep center and offers treatment for all adult and childhood sleep disorders, movement disorders, and insomnias. Our ENT specialists offer surgical and non-surgical treatments to address sleep apnea and other sleeping disorders.

UHealth Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery Division: The Division performs facial reconstructive surgery after trauma or alternative surgery and is superior in minimally invasive injectable cosmetic services.
