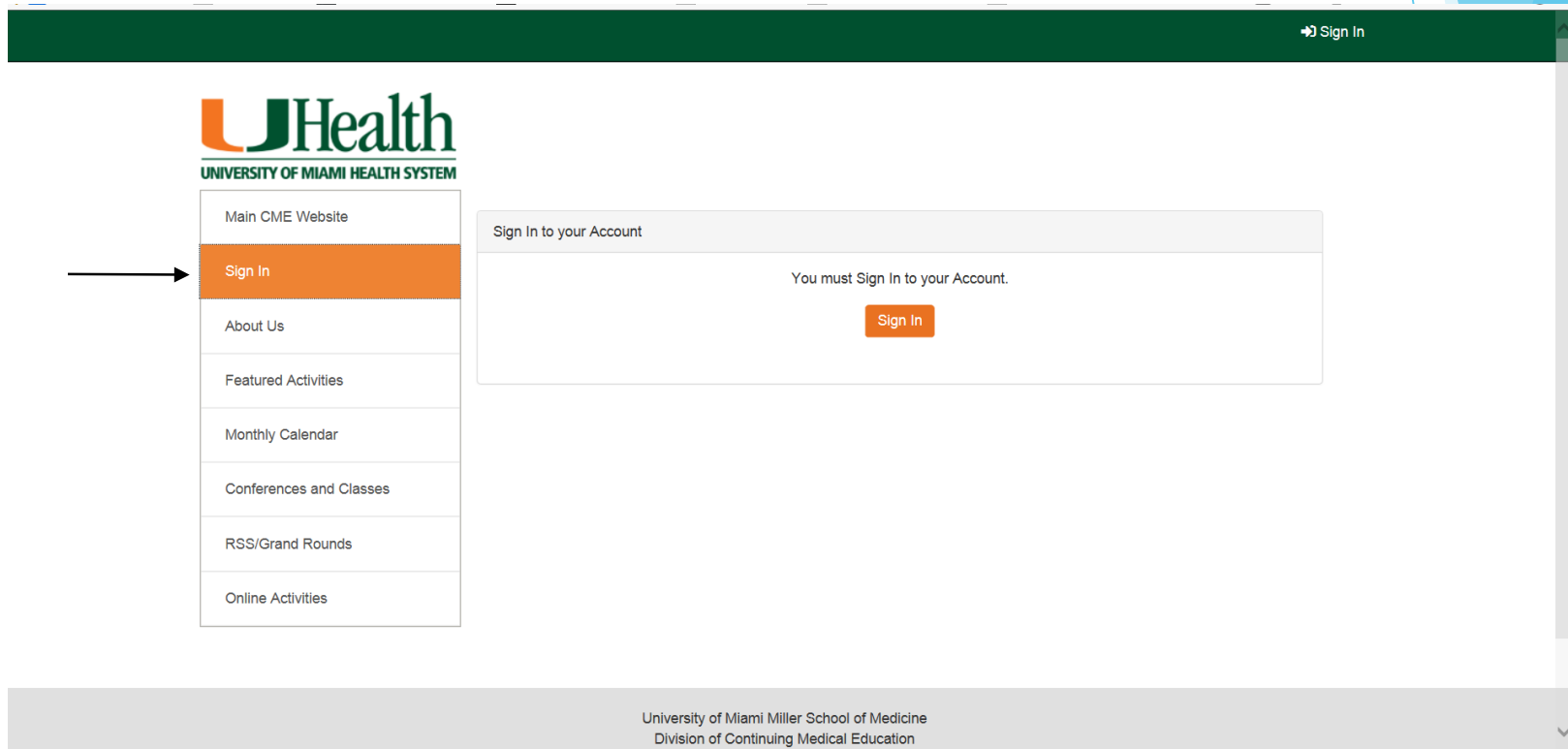
From your device:

- Create an account, or sign in with your credentials
- Click on 'Activity Check In'
- Enter the activity code provided during the Grand Rounds session.
Each session will have a unique code.
- Click 'Submit' and your attendance will be recorded.
