

City Officials Supporting the Fight Against Cancer at Fire Ops 101





The Environmental Sampling Project (ESP) has completed its first phase of data collection. The goal of ESP is to characterize the type and quantity of PAHs present on the skin of firefighters collected immediately before and after their work shift. Additionally, the ESP team wanted to characterize the type and quantity of VOCs present on the turnout gear of firefighters immediately after their work shift. The ESP research team was able to successfully sample the skin of over 40 City of Miami (COM) Firefighters and the turnout gear of 3 COM Firefighters. The success of this project is attributable to the collaborative efforts of City of Miami Fire Rescue, Miami Fire Central, and the University of Miami. Their endless commitment and dedication to this project continues to be the guiding force behind this initiative. ESP looks forward to continuing this study in the near future!
